**RULES for VENDORS**

- Date & Time: **Monday, October 12, 2009, 9:00 am to 4:00 pm.**
- Location: 589 Granby Road (Rte. 202), South Hadley, MA 01075
- Fees: **\$ 40.00** per space in the Gym; **\$ 30.00** per space in the Pavilion; or **\$ 25.00** per space on the Lawn. **\$ 5.00** for one 8' table.
- Space: Approximately 10' x 10'.
- Deadline: Please submit your application as soon as possible to reserve your space.
- Acceptance: **Please send a self-addressed, stamped envelope to receive your confirmation or provide your email address.** You will be notified promptly by mail or email if accepted.
- Refunds: Cancellations will be refunded up to September 12, 2009.
- Vendors: Tables or screens for display must have non-scratching feet (for use in the Gym). If you are in doubt, please check with the committee. These items must fit within your space. No flea market items, please.
- Electricity: Electricity is available at a limited number of booths in the Gym and Pavilion. If you require electricity be sure to mark the appropriate box on your application and we will do our best to accommodate your needs.
- Parking: Ample parking is available in our lot. Please move your vehicle to the far end after unloading to allow better access for the public.
- Advertising: Newspapers: Union News, Daily Hampshire Gazette, Turley Publications. TV Channels 22 & 40, posters, fliers and signs on Routes 202 & 33.
- Raffles: Raffles are not permitted.
- Food: Complimentary coffee and donuts will be available for the vendors, tickets will be provided to you at check-in. A bake sale and a light lunch menu will be available.
- Smoking: No smoking is permitted within the building.
- Alcohol: The sale or use of alcohol is not permitted.

Vendors must clear their area of packing materials, trash, etc. Neither Second Baptist Church of South Hadley, their agents, employees nor officers shall be held liable for failure to perform or fulfill its contractual obligation provided such failure is caused, occasioned or impeded by closures of site location due to any cause or causes beyond its control including but not limited to acts of God, strikes, lawful or not, fire, hurricane, smoke or water damage, or actions by legal authorities, etc. Nor shall promoter be responsible for loss or damage of vendor's wares, exhibits or personal property or for loss or injury caused by products sold or exhibited by vendors directly or through warranty, expressed or implied.
